TIMES

Students should arrive 1 hour before each schedule.

Shows rarely run on time. Come early to avoid missing your class. Classes will not wait for absent riders.

Show times will be e-mailed out the day before the show

NUMBERS

- Numbers will be available at the canteen 30 minutes prior to show start time
- Numbers must be worn on rider's back
- Numbers should be returned at the end of each show

PRIZES

Ribbons from 1st to 6th place at the end of each class

Champion and Reserve Champion for each Hunter division and Dressage division.

ATTIRE

- For riding you should wear beige or gray riding pants (dark is fine if you don't have a light pair), a riding blouse (or shirt with a raised neck), and a dark show jacket (solid dark sweater or sweatshirt). Riding boots, dark gloves, and certified helmets are mandatory. Come dressed for the forecasted weather.

ENTRIES

- Register electronically on our web site www.riverviewstables.ca
- Payment by e-transfer must accompany your entry form to be considered submitted.

CLASSES

- It is recommended to enter **ONE Entire Dressage Division** and **ONE Entire Hunter Division** (Unless you are entering the skills classes 1, 2, 3). This will make you eligible for division awards!
- Entries must be received one week prior to the show. Late entries will be accepted however a late fee will apply. Entry fees must accompany the entry forms. No refunds at any time!
- The show secretary has the right to move students into a more appropriate class if the class is not suitable for the rider. The level suitable for each student may vary depending on the entries at each show!

REMEMBER

- Our Canteen will be available. Please support our stable.
- The horse will not be judged. It is the rider's position and execution of transitions that will be judged. The rider will not be penalized for a horse's actions unless it is the rider who has created the situation.
- When competing at a show you should enter a level lower than what you are schooling. Our shows give students the opportunity to show what they already know.
- When choosing horses, please do not only put down Ruby, Twist, Darla as they are always in high demand. Riding a variety of horses will make you a better-rounded rider!
- If you have questions / problems, ask an instructor (not a student or the judge).
- HAVE FUN!!!
- Whether or not you win, remember that you are here because you love riding. Only one person will get the first-place ribbon, but everyone who tries his or her best is a winner!
